Homework

Homework will be set online each Thursday when the children have received their iPads. This will include: Spelling Shed, Reading, Sum Dog maths, Purple Mash tasks and Times Table Rockstars. We will ensure all children are confident in accessing homework tasks and all passwords will be provided via Dojo.

Reading

The children will be completing an online test over the next week in order to allocate them with the correct book for their reading level. Once your child has their book, please read with your child at home as often as possible and sign this off in their reading records. Our expectation is at least 3 times per week and children are rewarded for doing this. Books and reading diaries need to be in school every day. Reading books can be changed once the children have completed their book quiz in school or at home on Accelerated Reader. Children will also be given a book to read for pleasure from our twenty books to read before the end of year 4 list.

Snacks and water bottles

Children are permitted to bring in their own snack for break time, which should consist of a piece of fruit or vegetable sticks. Cavendish Close Junior Academy does not provide snacks for children to eat at break times. Children must bring in their own named water bottle from home which should only contain water.

<u>Nut Free School</u>

There are children in school who have a severe nut allergy. Not only are they allergic to nuts, they cannot tolerate having food substances with nuts in. Therefore, we are now a **nut free** school. Please ensure your child does not bring any nuts of food items to school which have nuts as a listed ingredient.

Working in Harmony Award

All children will be coming home with a Working in Harmony Award booklet soon. This is an award which we can all work together to achieve throughout this half term. There are allocated tasks for teachers, pupils and parents each week. Please support your child in completion of these activities and help them to earn a special certificate and badge.
