As part of this programme, we have various internet safety tasks to complete online with the school internet safety curriculum. Yesterday, these tasks helped us to identify **a video of a very sensitive nature on Tik Tok.**

We have followed our Safeguarding policies and procedures and we believe this video has now been removed; however, a number of children have shared that they have seen the video or have heard about the video. This will NOT have been in the school building due to our own filtering and security measures.

Therefore, please speak to your child and ensure you offer them appropriate support with internet safety. We encourage all parents/carers to check settings on social media applications on all home devices and regularly check what your child is accessing. Finally, as an additional reminder, please remember that children should not have their mobile phones in school and they should not be used by children inside the school gates.
