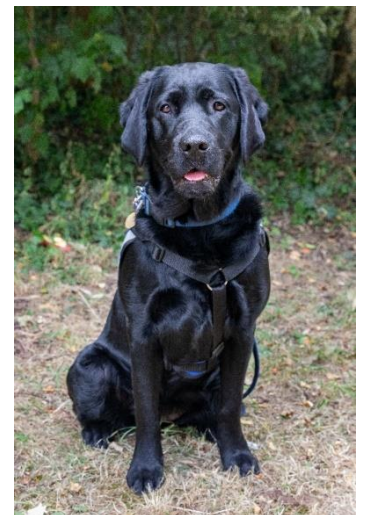

If you are worried by dogs, please don't be afraid of me. I'm very friendly and wouldn't want to hurt anybody. If you do see me around and are a bit worried, please just calmly walk away from me – if you run or make a big noise, I might think that you want to play with me.
