And the nation that pays it is lost!"



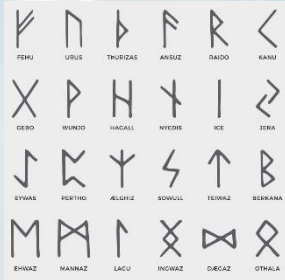
